- Certified partner's contact information
- Documentation of active project role
- Joint venture agreement



### **Evaluation Criteria**

- Financial stability & bonding capacity
- Experience & qualifications
- Past performance (projects, OSHA, wage compliance)
- Pricing & competitiveness
- M/W/DSBE & Section 3 participation
- EOP compliance potential
- Insurance & licensing

Misrepresentation or omissions

OSHA / L&I violations

Safety issues on prior projects

Fraudulent or inflated invoices/change orders

Unethical billing practices
