

Festival Pier Art Opportunity - Request for Qualifications

Q1 If I am a city employee, but also an artist, would I be considered for this project, or prevented from doing so since I'm a city employee?

A1 We would encourage you to submit your application along with an indication of your position with the city and a disclosure of any relationship you may have with the Art Program or the Development team in the written materials so that a determination can be made about any potential conflict of interest.

Q2 Is there a particular type of artist you are looking for?

A2 As stated in the Request for Qualifications document, the art opportunity is for an artist or artist team whose work would be appropriate for an exterior, high-traffic location with elements that are freestanding.

Q3 Can we submit a five-minute video of a project? I only see images in the info?

A3 The application portal can accommodate static visual materials only. If you would like to provide supplementary materials, you may provide a link in the written materials to view the video on a personal website or video-hosting website (such as vimeo or youtube) but this should not be a replacement for the static visual materials.

Q4 There are only 10 options under "number of files to upload," even though we are allowed to upload 15 images. So, how do we upload the other five images, when it seems that the limit is 10?

A4 Thank you, we have addressed the issue on the website.

Q5 A question concerning the Festival Pier RFQ. Can an individual artist apply for the project, with the possibility of adding other artists with different skills, or teaming up with other artists, in the future?
