

Lemon Hill Playground Public Bid Questions:

RFP Questions from D'Angelo Bros. Inc.

1. Has the existing material been tested in accordance with PADEP Clean Fill Standards? If the material has not been tested, who is responsible for testing the material?

The contractor is responsible for sampling and testing materials at a frequency determined by the disposal facility.

2. Can the material be managed as Clean Fill in accordance with the PADEP Clean Fill Standards? If the material cannot be managed as Clean Fill, what should we assume for bidding purposes? Will the contractor be paid for additional disposal costs if the material is not Clean Fill?

If contamination has been verified, there would be two unit costs for disposal

(one for clean fill and one for non-clean).

We suggest the inclusion of an if-and-where-directed line item in the bid form for testing and disposal of encountered soil suspected to be contaminated.

3. Can you please verify what other equipment or furnishings will be provided by the city or owner other than the playground equipment, if there is anything else?**The City will also provide the Dumor benches, Dumor picnic table sets, Dumor bike racks, and Dumor trash receptacles.**

4. Is there a geotechnical report for this project? If yes, can we have a copy of it?**The City does not have a geotechnical report for this project.**

5. Are there liquidated damages on this project? If yes, what are they?**Please refer to the SCR under Div 00 for clause against liquidated damages.**

6. The Bid documents have two different contract durations (150 Days and 180 Days). Which contract duration is correct?

180 days is the contract duration.

7. What are the MBE/WBE goals for this contract? Are there any requirements?**The City and PRA are not imposing MBE/WBE goals or requirements.**
