Tax Relief

- Homestead Exemption Save up to \$1,399 on your annual property tax bill; www.phila.gov/homestead or 215-686-9200
- Owner-Occupied Real Estate Tax Payment Agreement (OOPA) – Make affordable monthly payments on property taxes that are past due; www.phila.gov/oopa or 215-686-6442
- Senior Citizen Tax Freeze* Freeze Real Estate taxes for income- and age-eligible homeowners; www.phila.gov/ senior-freeze or 215-686-6442
- Longtime Owner Occupants Program (LOOP)* Freeze your property assessment if it rose by 50% or more in one year, or 75% over the past five years, and you've lived in your house for at least ten years; www.phila.gov/loop or 215-686-9200
- Low-Income Tax Freeze* income-eligible homeowners can freeze Real Estate taxes at the previous year's bill amount; (215) 686-6442
- Real Estate Tax Installment Plan* Monthly payment plans for senior citizens and eligible low-income homeowners; www.phila.gov/revenue/installment-plan or 215-686-6442
- Catastrophic Loss-Related Property Assessment*
 Reduce property assessment for properties that have lost 50% or more of their value due to fire or natural disaster;

- Real Estate Tax Credit for Active Duty Provides a tax credit for active military members called to duty outside of Pennsylvania; www.phila.gov/revenue/active-duty-tax-credit or 215-686-6442
